Term 6 will have the topic "Ye-Ha", with the question "Was it really the wild, wild, west?". The topic will include learning about The Great Plains of America - the geography, the wildlife and nature as well as the history of the Pioneers.

This will run alongside the class play "Ye-Ha" and will make sense of and explain the real history of the Native Americans. A lot of reading aloud skills will be covered by the play, such as reading aloud for meaning, working on intonation and pronunciation. Performing to their peers is also excellent for confidence building and speaking in public. Yr 6 will get the first choice of the characters to make it fair and where two children want the same role - mini auditions will be held.

All Art and Design Technology will be linked to the topic.
