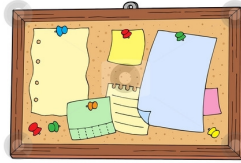
4. **Chestnut Class** - Chestnut Class are asking for donations of unwanted black leggings / joggers (aged 4-6) for girls. Thank you
