Please select at least three pieces of homework to complete by the end of term from the menu below. Our learning is continuing with 'Gods and Mortals'.

Read the story of Hercules before watching the film. Write a review to say which you preferred and why.	Be inspired by Greek theatre! Create a costume that could be used in a Greek play.	Read about Narcissus, the young man who fell in love with his own reflection. Draw/paint a self portrait.
Look carefully at the shapes of the letters of the Greek alphabet. Practise forming them and pronouncing them.	Read and retell the story of Medusa, the Gorgon, who could turn people to stone if they looked at her. Illustrate your story with a detailed drawing of Medusa's face, showing the snakes that sprouted from her head instead of hair!	Taste some traditional Greek dishes such as moussaka, baklava, feta cheese or taramasalata. Write a food review, describing what you have eaten.
Design a mythical creature. Which animals body parts could you include in your design? Make your creature using junk materials.	Hunt for columns, statues or pillars. Find out about different types of columns (Doric, Ionic and Corinthian) and see if you can spot any out and about.	Using your knowledge of Ancient Greece, create a quiz to test the class. Make sure you know the answers!
