2. **School Council** - On last term's 'Big Question afternoon', the House Captains and School Councillors asked to launch their 'Small change to make Big Change' campaign this term to raise money for their School Stationary Shop. 6. **Sports Day** - We are pleased to advise that Sports Day will be held on Friday 24th June. You may like to add the date to your diaries - further details will follow in due course.



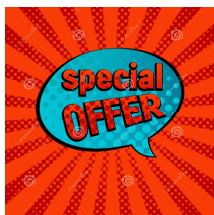
7. **Trainers** - A reminder that trainers worn to school as part of our Active Wear uniform must be black please.
