I hope you all had a lovely break. I am delighted to be working with the children in Maple Class and we have some exciting learning opportunities planned for Term 4.

This term, our focus in geography will be on exploring the world we live in. We will start by learning about the seven continents. From there, we will delve into the United Kingdom, studying its geographical features and the seas and oceans that surround it. We will be enjoying an immersion day in the second half of the term (date to be confirmed) where the children will be invited to dress in red, white and blue and have the opportunity to explore the United Kingdom in more creative ways.
