You may wonder why Leeds is part of our group as we are based in Kingswood. Well, back in 2003 Kingswood and Ulcombe as it was called, nearly closed down. We had the leaders but not enough children to keep it going. When Maidstone East District heard about this they asked other scout groups in the area if they would like to merge with us.

The Chairman from Leeds and Hollingbourne approached me and said 'you have the hut and we have the children, why don't we merge with you?' He said they have to rent the village hall and school for their meetings, so the groups got together to discuss about joining. It was agreed we will be called Leeds and Kingswood Scout Group.

Gloria is the only one from Leeds and Hollingbourne, along with Simon and myself from Kingswood and Ulcombe Scout Group, still involved with this group.

**SCOUTS:** We have 16 scouts. Amie Parker is the scout leader with four assistant leaders. The scouts went on their first camp, the weather was one of the wettest weekends, but this did not deter the children - they all had a great time. We had Remembrance Day service in Broomfield Church and also went to the Christmas Carol service, also at Broomfield Church.

**CUBS:** We have 22 cubs. Rickie is the new leader of the cubs - he was made leader at the beginning of the year. All the cubs, with other groups, had a sleep over in The Mall in Maidstone. The reason for the sleep over was to get an idea of homeless people having to sleep rough in doorways. This also gave the cubs an idea of being away from home.

**BEAVERS:** We have about 12 beavers. Their new beaver leader is Lydia and she took on the role at the start of this year. All the beavers are enjoying doing badge work.

**Mornings** - The gates open at 8.30am and the school day starts at 8.45am.
