#### Enjoy the Bank Holiday on Monday ... Maidstone Fun Fact

Until 1871 workers had only two paid days off a year - Good Friday and Christmas Day. In 1871 **Maidstone MP** Sir John Lubbock pushed an Act of Parliament through - the Bank Holiday Act 1871. From that moment on workers instantly got six paid Bank Holidays! (since increased to 8). The new paid days were SO popular they were initially known as 'Saint Lubbock Days'.
