Kent Strawberries at Wimbledon

Strawberries and Cream at The Wimbledon Championships are world famous!

The strawberries served at Wimbledon are a variety named 'Malling Centenary' and are produced by Hugh Lowe Farms, a family-run business located in Mereworth, just outside Maidstone. The farm is just 31 miles away from Wimbledon.

On average, 34.8 tonnes of strawberries are eaten each year during the Wimbledon Fortnight. An elephant weighs about 7 tons so you can imagine that 34.8 tonnes of strawberries is an awful lot!

To ensure there are enough strawberries grown for the July fortnight, 100,000 plants are planted in late March at the farm. The world-famous strawberries are ALL hand-picked and delivered to the All England Club each morning where they are inspected by the Food & Drink team. They make




sure only the best are served to their visitors who come from all around the world.

Any strawberries not eaten during the Wimbledon Fortnight are not wasted. They are frozen and used to make the strawberry jam for the scones and Victoria sponge served in their Café, which is open year round.

It was King Henry VIII who named Kent as 'The Garden of England' - a name that is still sued today.
