ASPIRE OLYMPICS 2024 - Kingswood Primary School

Aspire Federation is holding an Aspire Olympics **On Monday 22nd July 2024.**

This event is for all 4 of the Aspire schools, and has been planned to promote and celebrate the start of the 2024 Olympics in Paris.

Unfortunately, this event is **NOT** for parents or spectators. Due to the scale of the event, the day is just for the children and staff of the 4 schools. We will come together to celebrate and participate as a federation which will form the children's school day on Monday 22nd July - Schools will not be open as children are required to attend this event.

The event will take place at Ulcombe Village Recreation Ground and Hall, with Ulcombe Primary School being the main hub for the day. Each school will remain together with all members of staff present. Children will take part in a number of sporting activities throughout the day and compete to improve personal bests, as well as a competition format event. There will be an inflatable assault course, a trim trail and outdoor gym based at Ulcombe Primary School. Schools will have a time slot to visit the equipment and take part with their friends and teachers.

Based at the recreation ground will be a competition based football tournament for all ages run by EMC Academy and an athletics based circuit competition, where children will compete to gain personal bests across a variety of athletic based activities.

Children will walk to and from the school and village hall as a group, with extra members of staff from across Aspire accompanying the school staff during their transition.

Details for the event –

**Monday 22nd July
8.30-2.45pm**

Children of Kingswood Primary School should be dropped off at Ulcombe Village Hall at 8.30am

Kingswood staff will meet the children on the field and register them on their arrival. We ask that parents do not hang about once children have been handed over to Kingswood staff. This is to avoid car park congestion and to help with the smooth organisation of the day.

Children should be collected from Ulcombe Village hall at 2.45pm



Children should arrive at school in their active sports wear with trainers, school hoodie and a coat (Prepare for the English weather!) Children of Kingswood should wear a **green t-shirt** if possible - all schools have been given a t-shirt colour based on their uniform. If you do not have a **green t-shirt**, please wear your usual white PE t-shirt.

Children will require a packed lunch, snacks and suitable drinks for the duration of the day.

If you require a school packed lunch, please let the school office know by Friday 12th July.

There will be no hot school dinners available on this day.

With the very unpredictable weather at the moment, any decision to cancel (in the event of poor weather) could be a last minute decision. Should we have to cancel, the school will contact you via their usual method of communication. Please do not call the school office. In the event we have to cancel (this would be a last resort) schools would run as normal and children would be expected to stay at Ulcombe Primary School.

Children who are transported to and from school via a taxi, will be transported to the event via Aspire transport. They should arrive at Kingswood as normal, where a member of staff will travel with them to the event. They will be collected from Kingswood at the end of the day as per any other day. This also applies to any child who is booked in for wrap around care on the 22nd July.

We hope this will be an enjoyable, sunny day for everyone at Aspire!

Thank you for your continued support, and I look forward to welcoming the children from Kingswood to the Aspire Olympics 2024, on Monday 22nd July.

All children are expected to attend. Any absences that are not authorised will be recorded as unauthorised. **Please complete and return the attached consent form to the school office by Monday 15th July.**
