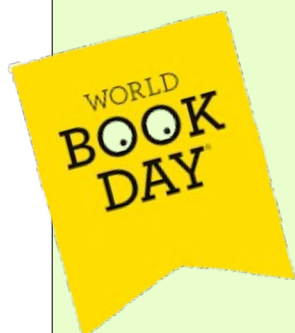
World Book Day is next week ...

A few polite reminders ...
