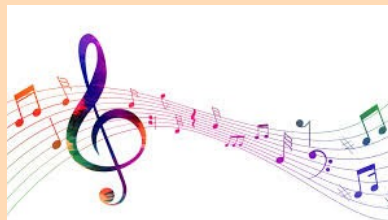

Unfortunately something is eating our seedlings!

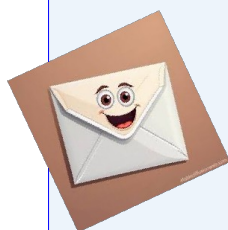
